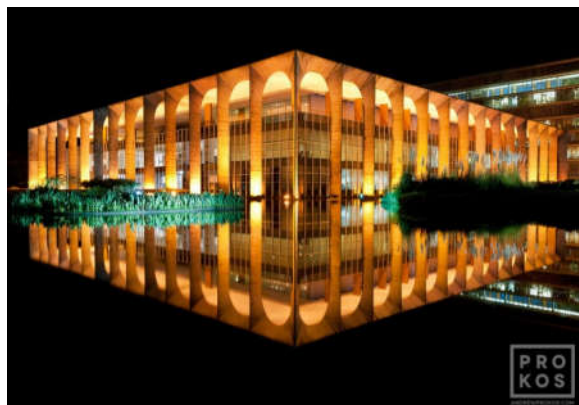
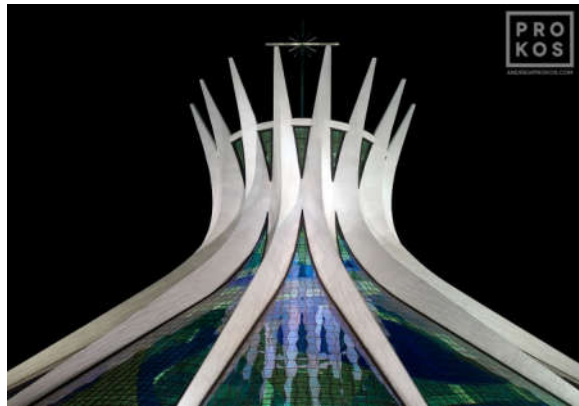
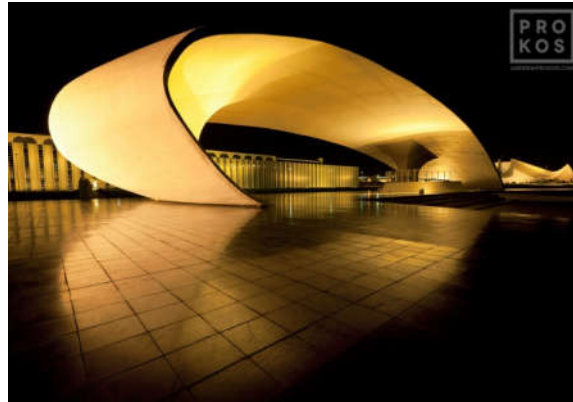


# NIEMEYER`s BRASILIA
